

Bill Scott is an International Society of Arboriculture Board Certified Master Arborist (earning the 2011 arborist of the year award) and Certified Municipal Specialist in addition to being an active certification proctor for the ISA. He is a 2008 graduate of the Society of Municipal Arborists Municipal Forester Institute.

He is also a Wyoming commercial pesticide applicator license holder and EPA pesticide handler/applicator trainer, and holds certificates in agroforestry, and natural resources management.

He has served on the ISA-RMC board of directors as the Wyoming State Director (2007-16), and as a member of the ISA-RMC education, and tree appraisal committees.
