Horticulture Growing: A Survey of Herbaceous Ornamental and Woody Plant Propagation

LECTURE DETAIL - The growing outcomes of Nursery and Greenhouse Production growing schedules, and the processes leading to viable Landscape plants will be the focus during this survey of Seed sources, growing mediums and propagation environments in relation to timing, scheduling and season.

Utilizing 'Botany Basics' during the first hour, Legerski will cover and share his experiences with Greenhouse propagation procedures. This propagation overview will include hands on, and interaction with the various components of greenhouse production. Seed, Soil, Light, and Water will be introduced, scrutinized and praised while determining our best growing practices for the crop at hand.

During the second part of this lecture Donald will be focusing attention to the process of schedule and profile development, Retail vs Wholesale models, securing, growing and installation of Native species in Wyoming and entertain discussion in relation to growing in Wyoming's unique challenges.
